Census data is confidential.

- Your personal information is protected by law and is never released to any other local, state, or federal agencies (Title 13 of the U.S. Code).

Census data affects your community.

- Census data determines federal funding to create maps to speed emergency services to assist those affected during a natural disaster.
- Planners use census data to determine where to build hospitals, shelters, and forecast future transportation needs for all segments of the population.

Responding to the Census is easy.

- You can respond to the U.S. Census online or over the phone in 13 languages, or wait for the paper form to be delivered to you.
