1	WHEREAS, infiltration and inflow (I&I) is ground water that enters the City's sewer
L2	system through cracks and/or breaches in the pipelines, which increases the volume of
L3	sewage conveyed in the system and ultimately the amount paid to the City of Hollywood
L4	by the City for wastewater treatment; and

L6	WHEREAS, the City has performed studies and rehabilitation work to 1) reduce
L7	I&I throughout its wastewater collection system, 2) help to increase the system's capacity
18	for base and peak flows and 3) strengthen preventative maintenance and operations
L9	activities by identifying and repairing any breaches/cracks in the pipelines, and broke the
20	work down to two phases known as Phase 2 - Mainline Repairs and Phase 2A - Lateral
21	Repairs; and

23	WHEREAS, in connection with the first phase, on February 19, 2019, the City
24	released Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2018-2019-003 and is now near completion of Phase
25	2 - Mainline Repairs to reduce infiltration and inflow (I&I) throughout its wastewater
26	collection system; and

28	WHEREAS, in connection with the second phase, on August 11, 2020, the City
29	released Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2019-2020-008 Infiltration and Inflow Removal Phase
30	2A - Lateral Repairs; and

32	WHEREAS, Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2019-2020-008 Infiltration and Inflow
33	Rernoval Phase 2Aateral Repairs was senit via email to over six hundred (600) veridors;

42	23, Section 23-12, Procedures for purchases in excess of \$50,000, (4) Rejection of Bids		
43	the City Commission may authorize City Manager to: a) Reject all bids; or b) reject all		
44	bids and re-advertise; and

46	WHEREAS, Staff recommends rejecting all bids and authorizing Staff to re-		
47	advertise the second phase of the project and authorizing the City Manager to execute		
48	any relating documents.

50	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY		
51	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
