	<p>On April 26, 2022, a team of assessors from the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA), will arrive in Hallandale Beach to examine all aspects of the Hallandale Beach Police Department policies, procedures, management, operations, and support services. Our agency must comply with approximately 250 standards critical to life, health, safety issues and best practices to maintain our current accredited status.</p> <p>The assessment team composed of law enforcement practitioners from similar agencies will review written materials, interview personnel, and physically visit offices and facilities of the Hallandale Beach Police Department where compliance can be observed.</p> <p>As part of the on-site assessment, agency members and the general public are invited to offer comments to the Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation Assessment Team. A copy of the standards manual is available through the Public Information Officer at 954-457-1426. The Accreditation Manager for the Hallandale Beach Police Department is Sharetta Ogden.</p> <p>For more information regarding CFA or if you wish to offer written comments about the Hallandale Beach Police Department's ability to meet the standards of Accreditation, please write to: CFA, P.O. The Hallandale Beach Police Department's accreditation is valid for three years.</p>
